

BOYS - GAME DAY INFO

3 Days Prior to Game Day:

1. Contact the other team's coach or manager to confirm the game date, time, location and uniform color.
2. Email your parents the above information and directions to the field if needed.
3. Print your Game Day Line UP from the EPYSA site with the login info you have in your books. Delco wants you to check only the Boys that will attend each game and then print this form (Landscape) and this gives you 3 of the same forms. One goes to the other team, one goes to the referees and you keep one so you have proof of who was there.

On Game Day:

1. Bring Team Line Up, player cards, coaches' cards and your team's share of the referee fees.
2. Give the referee a copy of your team line up, player cards and coaches' cards if he requests them.
3. Important: Get the referee's name for your post game report.
4. Exchange team rosters with the other coach.
5. Check the other team's roster and player cards for ineligible players. Guest players are permitted to play up but not down.
6. Before the game begins, inform the ref of any inaccuracies or ineligible players.
7. If there is a uniform color conflict, it is the home team's responsibility to change colors.
8. GCVSA Spectators and the opposing team sit on one side of the field. GCVSA spectators sit across the field from the GCVSA team VERY IMPORTANT.
9. Spectators are permitted from the center line down to 10 yards from the corner flag. Spectators are expected to not wander the side lines and to be respectful during the game.
10. If the spectators are unruly, the referee may issue a warning to the coach. If the rude behavior continues or escalates, the ref might eject the coach.
11. On your game report, document all yellow cards given to players, get uniform number, player name and what the infraction was.

Post-Game:

1. Get the player and coaches' cards from the referee.
2. The game report must be filed on the Delco website within 24 hours of the game. Consider printing the information from the game detail page to make reporting easier.
